

Maths Journey

We will be looking at number and place value and focusing on the four operations – adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing.

We will be applying our maths skills to our theme of Twisted Tales covering a range of mathematical strands. We will be navigating maps using co-ordinates and directional language.

We will look at statistics to create our own graphs to investigate questions linked to the collected data.

In Geography the children will be using coordinates and directional language to help them explore the maps and journeys.

PSHE/P4C

We are looking at being healthy and staying safe. In philosophy sessions we will think about our local area and what makes us a good citizen. We will constantly make links to our school learner values helping us to become lifelong learners and recognise these qualities in others.

English/MoE, communication & Language

English/MoE- The children will be working with a variety of genres in English linked to our theme. As a team of Fairy-tale Problem Solvers, they will need to answer letters with urgency – both informal and informal. We will be creating character profiles linked to the characters we meet. We will immerse ourselves in some poetry linked to our forest. No doubt Little Red Riding Hood will need better directions/instructions to get to Granny's house too!

Letters and Sounds-The children will be working through phases 3-6 and linking their phonic development with the technical demands of handwriting joins.

MFL – In French the children will learn a range of greetings, numbers to 10 and names of colours. We will be using song to help us learn new French vocabulary.

History and Geography

We will be researching and learning about the Stuart. This will include the Great Fire of London, the Black Plague and Bonfire Night.

We will be exploring and developing our geographical skills – locating Exeter and London on maps. Comparing and contrasting the two cities. Link our history of London with our geography.
