Head lice

There has been a number of cases of Head Lice reported. Please check your children's and close family members' heads tonight and regularly over the holidays. We would recommend that you use a 'louse comb' (available from chemists) on wet hair with plenty of conditioner applied.

If any Head Lice are found, please treat with Derbac M, Quellada M or Suleo M. People with eczema need to use water-based lotions, which are Derbac M or Quellada M.

An alternative to the use of insecticides is to use the 'wet combing' method every other day for two weeks. This should ensure that all live lice, including any which might have hatched during the two-week period, are removed.


