English:

We will be writing facts about the Isles of Scilly using expanded noun phrases. We will also be creating our own leaflets and posters encouraging people to visit the Isles of Scilly. Later in the autumn term we will be writing a short story about the mythical creature that has arrived in the waters!

Music - Hey You!

Hey You! by Joanna Mangona - an Old-School Hip Hop tune written for children.

Focused songs: Me, Myself And I by De La Soul, Fresh Prince Of Bel-Air by Will Smith, Rapper's Delight by The Sugarhill Gang, U Can't Touch This by MC Hammer, It's Like That by Run DMC. This unit will teach the children to enjoy moving to music by dancing, marching, being animals and popstars!

Science:

We will be identifying and naming a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees. We will also be identifying and describing the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees. We will be observing and describing how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants, finding out and describing how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.
