### IMPORTANT

Once again COVID regulations have changed—this now means that you are able to start testing using lateral flows from Day 5, in order to reduce your isolation period. Negative results on two consecutive days (24 hours apart) means that isolation ends at that point. Please remember that the day you initially test positive is recorded as Day 0. Isolation ends officially at midnight on Day 10 and there is no need to LFT beyond that point. Please keep us informed of LFT results as soon as you child tests negative for the first time, so that we can anticipate their return.

We will continue to try and open up the curriculum to include enrichment trips and events throughout the year, keeping in line with COVID-19 health and safety guidance, as long as venues are still happy to host us. Please be mindful that there may be occasions where plans have to change at the last minute because of local Covid rates or staffing availability.

We are really pleased that some of our Year 5/6 pupils will be out on an educational visit to Belmont Chapel next Monday morning to experience the LIFE exhibition. The exhibition hosts school groups from UKS2, to give them the opportunity to question who Jesus is to them. Using interactive technology, pupils explore what the Bible teaches about Jesus's birth, his words and teaching, his miracles and his death and resurrection. We will look forward to hearing all about the exhibition next week!
