IMPORTANT MESSAGE

Covid Update – I am sure you are all, like us, trying to follow and keep up with the ever changing rules and guidance, If it is helpful here is a summary of what we think the latest change (from Mon 11th January) is:

People in England are now allowed to leave self-isolation as long as they provide two negative lateral flow tests. The first LFT should be taken on day 6 and if that is negative they should take another LFT 24 hours later on day 7. They will be permitted to leave isolation immediately after the second test if that is also negative—so if both tests are before the start of the school day then they may return on Day 7 .
If LFTs are still positive the person must continue to isolate. If no lateral flows are done, they must continue to isolate for the full 10 days.
