Dear Parents,

Our Spring term parents evening appointments will be held in the final week of this term (next week) or the first week of the summer term. Unfortunately, staff absence has meant that it was difficult to schedule them all before we break up for the Easter holidays. These meetings will take place on TEAMs and you will receive appointments directly from the class teacher. If you are unable to make the scheduled time/date, please let the teacher know, they will then be happy to reschedule the meeting to a more convenient time and this will avoid them wasting time waiting for you to join the meeting.

You may be aware that there is now new Guidance in place (from 1/4/22) with regards to COVID and school attendance. Lateral Flow Tests are no longer available for free to the majority of people (this includes schools). Therefore the general population is advised not to routinely test anymore.

From 1 April, updated guidance advises people with symptoms of a respiratory infection, including COVID-19, and a high temperature or who feel unwell, to try stay at home and avoid contact with other people, until they feel well enough to resume normal activities and they no longer have a high temperature.

There are some exceptional circumstances when a COVID test needs to be taken eg to travel, If this returned a positive result then it is advised you should stay home for 5 days whilst you are most infectious, to reduce the risk of passing the infection to others.
